

DINOSAUR TAILS

MATERIALS + TOOLS:

two shades of green felt (or red and orange for the other dinos)
fabric scissors
tape
pen

elastic strap
hot glue gun
safety pin



1 Draw the shape of a dinosaur tail on your light green felt, making sure to leave an extra 2-3 inches at the top. Cut your tail.



2 Draw nebulous shapes on the dark green felt and cut them out.



3 Adhere them to the tail with hot glue.



4 Fold the top edge over and glue in place.



5 Cut a piece of elastic strap that is slightly longer than your child's waist. Add a safety pin to the end of the elastic strap, then file the strap through the top of the tail.



6 Remove the safety pin and tie the ends of the elastic strap together. Rotate the strap so that the tied portion is covered by the folded part of the tail.

MATERIALS + TOOLS:

balloons
paper (colorful paper if you want!)
scissors
pen
tape
fishing line



1
Start by adding helium to your balloons. Next, draw legs, tails and necks for your dino balloons.



2
Cut them out and adhere them to the balloon with tape.



3
Tie one piece of fishing line around the base of the balloon, then tape a second piece of fishing line to the opposite end.

scissors
tape



1
Cut out the square, then fold it in half vertically.



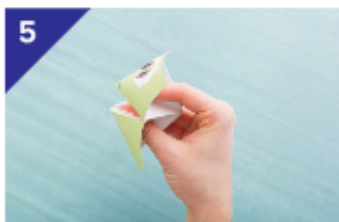
2
Open it back up and fold it horizontally. Make sure to really crease the paper.



3
Next, turn the image face down, then fold in the corners until they meet in the middle.



4
Now flip it over so the eyes face the table. Fold in all of the corners again.

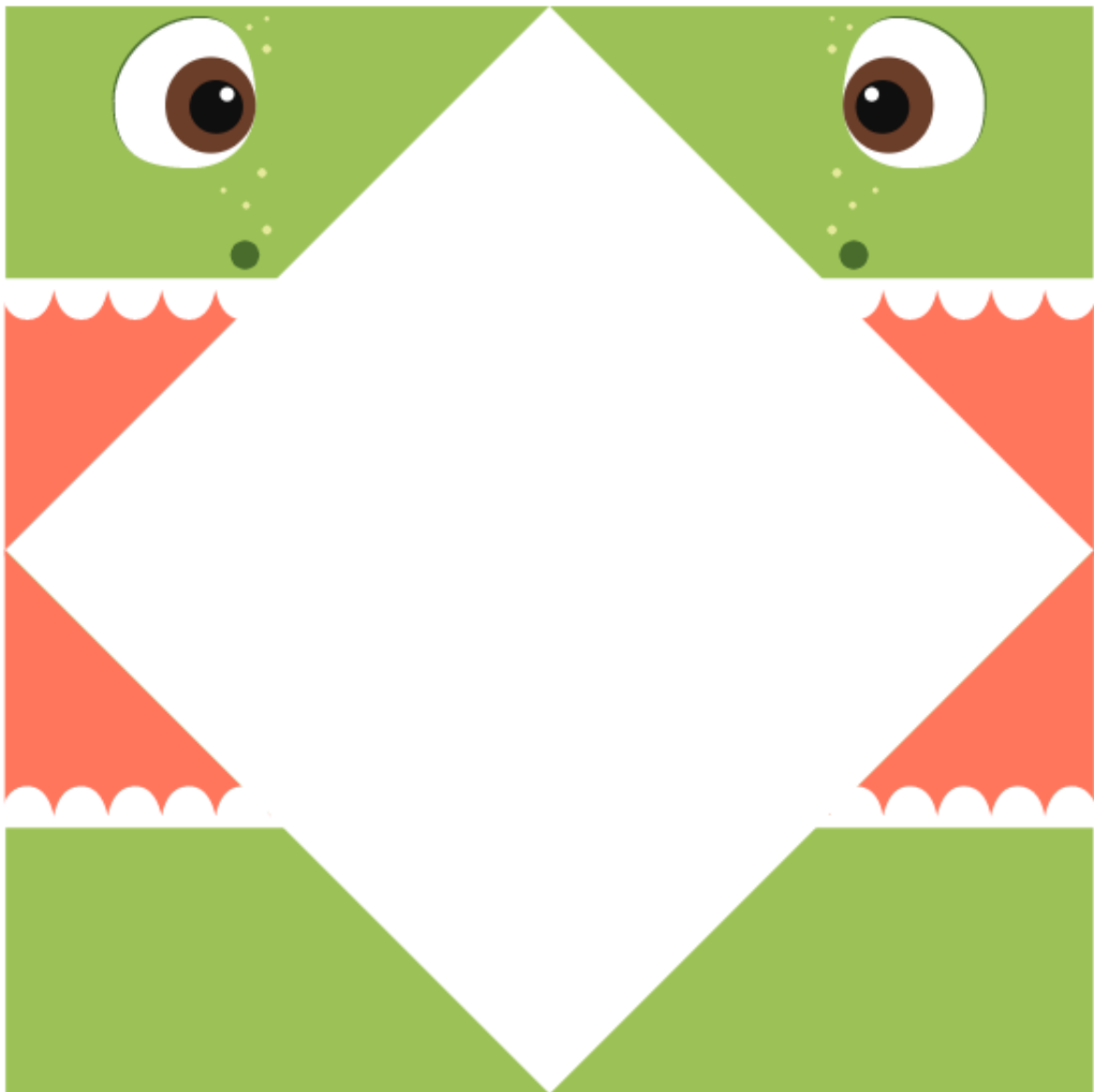


5
Put your fingers into the open flaps and form it into shape.

*To make Spot, cut out and tape on his wild hair behind the top flaps. Round the corners on the bottom section of the printable.

MATERIALS + TOOLS:

dinosaur cookie cutters
food coloring pens



1 Use a recipe for sugar cookies that won't expand too much and icing that hardens. Use dinosaur cookie cutters to create your cookies.



2 Bake them according to the recipe's instructions.



3 Let cookies cool. Add a layer of icing and let it harden.



4 Draw patterns and designs on the cookies with food coloring pens.
